PLEASE DISREGARD PREVIOUS LETTER

Dear Outpatient Behavioral Health Providers:

OHCA recently received written approval from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services on the State Plan Amendment regarding Outpatient Behavioral Health Services rule 317:30-5-240-248, incorporating new substance abuse treatment specific codes, criteria for Alcohol and or other Drug Treatment Professionals (AODTP), and the behavioral health aide service for children in a Systems of Care program. Unfortunately, we did not get CMS approval for the "mental health clubhouse" services for those agencies who are ICCD accredited. OHCA will be implementing these new rules as of August 1, 2005 to allow providers time to train and make changes within their internal systems. OHCA, OFMQ, and ODMHSAS will be conducting provider trainings July 26th (Tulsa-OSU), July 28th (Lawton-Great Plains Tech Center), and August 2nd (OKC-MetroTech-Springlake) to go over the new rules, prior authorization manual and forms, types of cases, and progress notes. Attached is the table showing all procedure codes, modifiers, and rates.

Substance Abuse Treatment question: What do we do with our current authorizations? This will be handled differently according to your provider type: Public, Private, or ODMHSAS contracted (see below for instructions).

- 1) Public Providers (CMHCs) - you will begin using a "HF" substance abuse (SA) treatment modifier on billing for SA/Integrated services rendered 8/1/05 and after, as well as you can begin using the new AOD codes (no modifier needed on these). For cases that are only mental health (MH), you will continue to bill as usual.
- 2) ODMHSAS Contracted providers - OHCA will need a list of your current PAs for Substance abuse cases so that we can update the current PAs by adding the "HF" modifier for services rendered 8/1/05 or after. Then on all new PA requests you will specify whether the case is a MH case or a SA case. The SA case PAs will have the "HF" modifier on them and will need to be billed using this modifier. MH cases will be PA'd and billed as usual.
- 3) Private Providers - you will just bill out your current PAs as they are. Then on all new PA requests you will specify whether the case is a MH case or a SA case. The SA case PAs will have the "HF" modifier on them and will need to be billed using this modifier. MH cases will be PA'd and billed as usual.

AODTP question: Who is qualified to be an AODTP? 317:30-5-240:
Alcohol and other Drug Treatment Professionals are defined as practitioners who are:

- (1) Licensed to practice as an Alcohol and Drug Counselor in the state in which services are provided, or those actively and regularly receiving board approved supervision to become licensed;
- (2) Certified as an Advanced Alcohol and Drug Counselor as recognized by an ODMHSAS recognized and approved AOD treatment certifying and/or licensing body;
- (3) Certified as an Alcohol and Drug Counselor as recognized by an ODMHSAS recognized and approved AOD treatment certifying and/or licensing body; or
- (3) A MHP with a current license to practice who can demonstrate competency in the area of alcohol and drug counseling and treatment.

Behavioral Health Aide question: Who can bill these services? 317:30-5-241:
This service is limited to children who are in an ODMHSAS contracted systems of care community based treatment program(see codes/rates attached).

All providers will be getting a letter from OFMQ regarding the Provider Trainings with detailed information. All training materials will also be made available on the OFMQ website www.ofmq.com, go to Behavioral Health and then to Outpatient Services.
